**Entry visas** 

when visiting Iran...





- **1-** The main types of visa issued for Iran are:
  - Tourist Visa
  - Business Visa
  - Press Visa
  - Transit Visa
  - Work Visa
  - Pilgrimage Visa
  - Student Visa
  - Diplomatic and Service Visa
- **2-** Visas on arrival are only available at airports, and they're now valid for 30 days. Over landers, you'll have to get a visa at a consulate ahead of time.
- **3-** If you can't get a visa on arrival, you need to get a visa at a consulate. Citizens of the United States, United Kingdom, Canada, Bangladesh, Jordan, Iraq, Afghanistan, and Pakistan need to get consular visas, and need to get an authorization number before applying for the visa.
- **4-** If there is proof of entry to Israel in your passport, you cannot enter Iran.



- **5-** All foreign visitors require a visa to enter Iran except citizens of the following countries: Syria, Turkey, Lebanon, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Bolivia and Egypt. Citizens of these countries can stay for up to 2 months without a visa.
- **6-** Application for extension of visas, including entry, tourist and pilgrimage visas, are issued by Police Department of Aliens Affairs on the basis of justifiable reasons and approval of the mentioned Bureau.

Diplomatic and service visa will be extended by the Ministry of Foreign affairs upon the request of the concerned foreign Diplomatic mission in Tehran.

Work permit visa will be extended by Police Aliens Affairs Dep. with Coordination of the Department of Aliens Employment at the ministry of labor and Social Affairs and on the basis of request by the Iranian sponsor of the applicant.
